

## **Fire Walk 2026 Terms and Conditions**

### **Registration:**

- Online registration will close at **12pm on 17th September 2026**. After this date, please call **01472 350908** to register
- Participants cannot register on the day for the FireWalk · The registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable; it contributes to the cost of staging the event
- Any participants aged between 12 & 18 years must be accompanied by an adult.

### **Sponsorship:**

- This is a sponsored charity Fire Walk; by registering you agree to raise funds for St Andrew's Hospice and to encourage sponsorship from others. There is a minimum fundraising target of £100
- All funds are to be sent to St Andrew's Hospice, (Peaks Lane, DN32 9RP) within thirty days after the date of the Fire Walk.

### **Sending Sponsorship Money:**

- Please do not send cash in the post. You can bring cash directly to the hospice.

### **Personal Details and Emergency Contacts:**

- All participants must provide their home address (including postcode), email address, and phone number
- You must also provide an emergency contact number for who will be available on the day.

### **Non-Participation:**

- If you can no longer take part in the Fire Walk, please inform us as soon as possible so that your place can be allocated to someone else.

### **Use of Funds:**

- You are not permitted to use sponsorship money to cover personal expenses. All funds raised must go directly to St Andrew's Hospice.

### **Cancellation:**

- If for reasons out of our control this event cannot go ahead it may postpone or cancelled, anyone who has purchased a ticket will be contacted as soon as this decision is made and notified of next steps
- In the event of cancellation or postponement, the hospice will contact you via direct email and use social media posts to update you accordingly. If the weather is poor, please keep an eye on this and expect to be contacted.

### **Liability:**

- St Andrew's Hospice has taken all reasonable steps to eliminate the chance of injury, but there is a certain minimal risk in every activity, and you should withdraw from the event if you have any doubts. All participants take part at their own risk. St Andrew's Hospice accepts no responsibility to participants and spectators for any injuries, accidents, loss, damage, or public liability whatsoever, including indirect punitive, special incidental, or consequential losses which may be sustained in the course of this event other than personal injury (including death) caused by our negligence. All participants will sign a waiver of personal injury
- By registering for this event, you are agreeing that any official photographs and videos taken can be used by St Andrew's Hospice for promotional purposes. If you would like to take part in this event but opt out of being in any official photographs, please contact us after booking
- We hope you'll share your photos and videos from the event with us on social media. By doing so, you agree we share these and use them for promotional purposes

### **Participant Guidance:**

- Participants must be in good physical health and have no medical conditions that could be aggravated by their participation in this event. It is the responsibility of the entrant to participate only if you are fit and able to do so. We do not recommend taking part if you are pregnant, have any underlying heart or respiratory condition, please consult a doctor prior to taking part if necessary

- Participants must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs
- This event is unsuitable for any children under the age of 12.

### **Refund Policy:**

- St Andrew's Hospice event tickets and registration fees are regarded as donations and are therefore **non-refundable**
- In the event you cannot attend, your place may be transferred to another designated attendee
