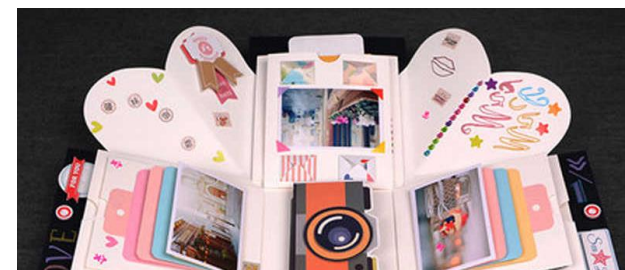

Family & Bereavement Support Volunteer:

Through the provision of emotional support to patients and their families, our family support function facilitate a variety of group, wellbeing and bereavement groups across the service.



Befriender at Home Volunteer: Our trained volunteers provide companionship, support and encouragement to people accessing our services from their own home, via help with everyday tasks and activities.



Creative & Therapeutic Activity Volunteer:

Through the facilitation of creative, garden and social activities in one-to-one, family and group work settings, our volunteer team deliver hands on activities, with creative concepts and flair.

Therapy Services Volunteer:

The hospice provides a range of treatment services, including complementary therapy, hydrotherapy and physiotherapy. Each provision establishes key treatments in line with patient need, delivered within the Wellbeing Retreat.

Hair & Beauty Salon Volunteer:

Based within the Wellbeing Retreat our Hair Studio is open to patients, families and the general public, with the volunteer team assisting in the day to day activities within the salon.

Wellbeing Volunteer:

Based within the main Hub and supporting the Wellbeing Nursing Team, volunteers assist patients with pre-planned appointments and wellbeing sessions, through effective communication, support and via a dedicated approach to their needs.
