

Accessing medications

I can't leave my house, how can I get my medication?

Phone your GP surgery if you need a prescription. Your GP may be able to send this straight to your pharmacy, ask them if this is possible.

You can then ask a family member, friend or neighbour if they can pick the medicines up for you from the pharmacy. Some pharmacies can deliver your medicines, give your pharmacist a call or check online.

Remember that this process can take a few days so try to plan ahead. If you need your medication quickly, let your GP and pharmacist know.

If your medication isn't available, your GP will be able to advise on what you should do.
